REGIONAL COORDINATION MECHANISMS

- 12 emergency response training sessions organized for 187 participants
- 1 civil-military workshop with 124 participants
- 1 contingency stock prepositioned in Guadeloupe covering the needs of 500 families
- 1 plot of land acquired in Guadeloupe for the construction of a regional humanitarian warehouse
- 1 regional disaster risk management workshop held with 35 participants
- **9 workshops on disaster law** with 311 participants



- 4 National Red Cross equipped with warehouses & stock of essential goods covering 120 households
- 1 storage capacity **monitoring tool** implemented
- 1 e-learning course created on storage capacity management
- 1 logistics manual reinforced on the principles of protection, gender & inclusion
- **5 awareness raising & training sessions** on first aid & psychological first aid for 189 participants



ECONOMIC RESILIENCE OF SME'S

- 1 study on small & medium business owners' vulnerabilities & disaster preparedness capacities
- **3 business forums** organized with 32 business owners
- **6 awareness actions** targeting 262 SMEs & 43 business support organizations
- 4 preparedness coaching workshops conducted with 38 entrepreneurs
- 11 SMEs coached to develop their business continuity plan
- 1 mobile preparedness application adapted to the needs of Caribbean SMEs



AWARENESS OF NATURAL RISKS & ADAPTATION TO CLIMATE CHANGE

- **1 study** on the knowledge, attitudes & practices of the Caribbean populations regarding natural hazards & climate change
- 64 multi-risk prevention & climate change awareness messages disseminated to the general public in the Caribbean
- **2 training sessions** for 92 participants on data collection & risk reduction awareness
